Long-term Care Home/Retirement Home Roles and Responsibilities

Surv	veillance:
	Identify ill/symptomatic residents.
	Start a line list as soon as any residents have respiratory symptoms.
	Complete a separate line list for symptomatic staff.
Rep	orting requirements:
	Contact Public Health Sudbury & Districts, Clinical Services Division at 705.690.1939 to report the outbreak.
	Complete the preliminary report of an institutional outbreak form and fax to 705.677.9618.
	After hours and weekends call 705.688.4366 to page the on-call staff to report the suspected outbreak.
	Obtain an outbreak number from Public Health Sudbury & Districts.
	Fax the line list to the public health nurse at 705.677.9618.
	Line lists must be faxed daily by 10 a.m. for the duration of the outbreak.
	Fax any additions or changes to the line listing promptly and notify the public health nurse by phone of the updated line list being faxed.
	$Consult\ with\ the\ public\ health\ nurse\ re:\ collecting\ nasopharyngeal\ swabs\ (NP\ swabs)\ and\ infection\ control\ measures$
	Notify your facility's Director, Outbreak Management Team and staff about the outbreak and review all infection control measures implemented.
	Notify the coroner and Public Health Sudbury & Districts of any deaths that occur during the outbreak.
	ction control measures for heightened surveillance or declared outbreak: litional recommendations may be required in consultation with Public Health)
	Isolate and cohort symptomatic residents.
	Obtain NP swabs as recommended by Public Health Sudbury & Districts.
	Ill staff should not be permitted to work.
	Post appropriate signage at each entrance to the facility once the outbreak is declared.
	Ensure alcohol-based hand rub is available at each entrance for visitor use.
	Implement droplet/contact precautions and ensure that adequate supplies of personal protective equipment (PPE) are available for use by any staff or family members providing care.
	Increase frequency of environmental cleaning, especially commonly touched surfaces.
	Reinforce diligence in hand washing and use of alcohol-based hand rub for staff, visitors and residents.
	Symptomatic residents should receive tray meal service in their room.
	Ill visitors should not enter the facility.
