

Third dose of COVID-19 vaccine recommended for immunocompromised individuals

If you have certain immunocompromising conditions, you need a third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine **8 weeks (56 days)** after your second dose to be fully vaccinated. A fourth (booster) dose is also recommended **3 months (84 days) after your third dose**.

Without it, you are at higher risk of contracting COVID-19 and its variants.

Talk to your health care provider to see if you are eligible.
