Getting your children vaccinated according to the recommended immunization schedule is one of the most important things parents/guardians can do to protect their child's health. Diseases spread quickly among groups of children who are not vaccinated.

## Did you know?

Vaccines are very safe, thoroughly tested before Health Canada approves their use, and carefully monitored after they are licensed to ensure their safety.

Immunization not only protects vaccinated children but entire communities of children by preventing and reducing the spread of infectious diseases.

Reporting your child's immunizations to Public Health Sudbury & Districts will ensure their vaccination record is up to date.

Outbreaks of vaccine preventable diseases occur when children are not vaccinated.
