Comirnaty® Pfizer-BioNTech 6 doses per multi-dose vial	 Previously immunized high-risk populations who have completed their primary series should receive an additional dose of COVID-19 vaccine: Adults 80 years and older should receive an additional dose of vaccine 65 to 79 years of age may receive an additional dose of vaccine. Adult residents of long-term care homes and other congregate living settings for seniors. Individuals 55 years and older who identify as First Nations, Inuit, or Metis and their non-Indigenous household members who are 55 years and older. Individuals 12 years of age and older who are moderately to severely immunocompromised (due to an underlying condition or treatment).

Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV)			
Abrysvo® 1 dose box	Aged 60 years of age and older and meets one of the following descriptors (please check): Resident in long-term care homes (LTCH), Elder Care Lodge, or retirement home. In a hospital receiving alternate level of care (ALC), or a similar setting (complex continuing care or hospital transitional programs). They are receiving hemodialysis or peritoneal dialysis. They are a recipient of solid organ or hematopoietic stem cell transplants. They are experiencing homelessness. They identify as First Nations, Inuit, or Métis. Patients with glomerulonephritis (GN) who are moderately to severely immunocompromised. If an individual received a dose of RSV vaccine during the 2023-2024 season, they are not eligible to receive another dose during the 2024-2025 season. Vaccine unavailable for pregnant individuals until fall respiratory 2025 campaign.		
Beyfortus® 50mg and 100 mg Monoclonal antibody immunizing agent	Unavailable until fall respiratory 2025 campaign.

- 1. Include cold chain compliant vaccine fridge temperature logs from the previous 2 weeks indicating that the maximum, minimum, and current temperatures have been taken twice daily at the beginning and the end of each day.
- 2. Orders submitted Monday through Thursday are packed on the Friday of the same week.
- 3. All orders are ready for pick up the first business day of the following week.
- 4. An insulated, pre-conditioned cooler with cooler blankets, ice packs, and a temperature monitoring device are required to transport vaccines.
- 5. Pick-up hours: 8:30 a.m.- noon or 1-4:30 p.m., excluding statutory holidays.
